

Alcohol Use Guidelines

NatureBridge is a non-profit organization dedicated to connecting people to the wonder and science of the natural world, igniting self-discovery and inspiring stewardship of our planet. In order to provide a safe and comfortable environment for all participants of NatureBridge, we require that all guests abide by our alcohol use guidelines. Failure to comply with these guidelines can result in removal from the NatureBridge site.

Alcohol use at NatureBridge: Lake Crescent

1. The responsible consumption of beer and wine alcoholic beverages is permitted for participants who are 21 years of age or over.
2. It is the responsibility of the family cohort to assure compliance with all federal, state and local laws concerning the consumption of alcohol and the Alcohol Use Policy of NatureBridge.
3. Hard alcohol is prohibited.
4. Beer and wine may not be consumed in the parking area at the NatureBridge campus or public areas within Olympic National park.
5. Beer and wine may be served only by a member of the group that is 21 years of age or older.
6. Guests under age 21 may not acquire, possess, or consume alcohol. Nor may other persons furnish alcohol to anyone under 21 or permit any underage consumption.
7. Any person who chooses to drink alcoholic beverages should be advised by the family cohort that they are expected to do so responsibly and at their own risk. Participants should be asked by the family cohort not to drive in the park if they have consumed alcohol
8. Participants will be asked to leave if they fail to comply with these guidelines or if their behavior infringes on the rights of other participants.

Your compliance with NatureBridge's Alcohol Use Guidelines helps ensure that both participants and staff have a safe and comfortable place to learn and enjoy themselves. Thank you for working with our staff to create an atmosphere of fun and learning.
