Guided by NatureBridge educators and National Park Service Wilderness Education Rangers, WildLink students journey across Yosemite over a six-day adventure that seeks to strengthen, empower and connect young people to our public lands.

Program Outcomes

- Participants gain a sense of belonging in wild places and a deeper appreciation for the natural world
- Participants develop a sense of stewardship and are inspired to care for their environment and home communities through ambassador projects
- Participants gain skills for navigating and exploring Wilderness in a safe and responsible manner and the ability to pass on this knowledge and experience to their home communities

Program Details

- Grades 9–12
- Spring, Fall or Summer (nine trips per year)
- Free for participants

Sample Activities

- Explore personal connections to the land and how wild experiences can influence our day-to-day lives
- Hike along a waterfall, river or stream while learning about watersheds, hydrology and geology
- Debate Wilderness Management scenarios like fire management, installations, social media, overcrowding, etc.
